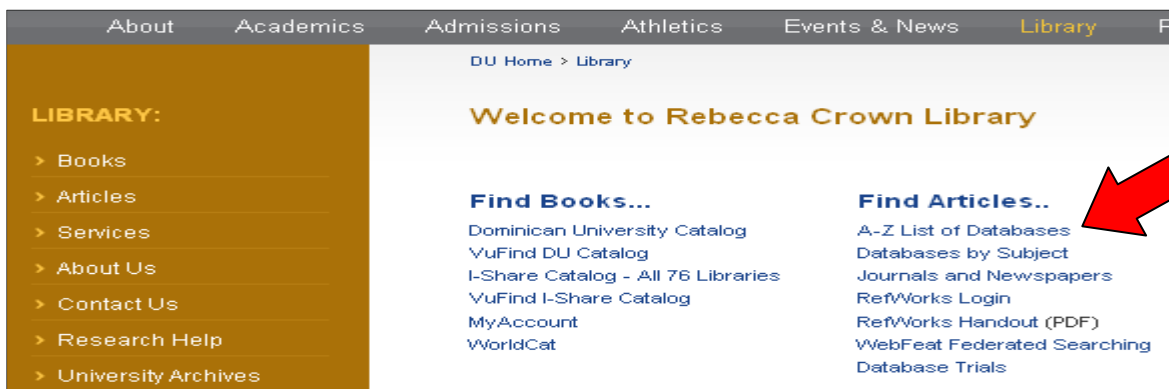


Receive New Book Reviews in Your Discipline from *Choice*

“*Choice: Current Reviews for Academic Libraries* is the premier source for reviews of academic books, electronic media, and Internet resources of interest to those in higher education. More than 35,000 librarians, faculty, and key decision makers rely on *Choice* magazine and *Choice Reviews Online* for collection development and scholarly research.” (From *Choice’s* About Us page)

Follow the steps below to have the *Choice* list of new books in your discipline sent to you every month via email. **Access to reviews of those books requires you to log in to *Choice’s* web site. Our license allows for only 2 simultaneous users.** This license agreement does not affect your monthly email.


1. Access *Choice* through the Library web site by clicking the **A-Z List of Databases**, and then on ***Choice Reviews Online*** under **C**.



2. Click on **REGISTER** here to create your profile and fill out the form.







3. After you enter your personal information, you can choose your email format and the subject areas in which you'll receive new book lists. You can choose as many subjects as you want. Please ask your library liaison if you have questions about the subjects.
4. Choose the readership level, *Choice* recommendation and format. It is suggested you **select all readership levels**; at least the **Optional, Recommended, Highly Recommended and Essential Choice** recommendations; and **All Titles** under Format.
5. Click on **Update My Profile**.
6. Each month you'll receive an email with the list of new books in the subject(s) you specified when you created your profile. There are 2 ways to read reviews of those new books: read individual reviews by **clicking on specific titles** in the email (steps 7-8) OR read **My Monthly Reviews** (steps 9-11). Clicking on specific titles gives you one review at a time. My Monthly Reviews gives you all titles and reviews at once.
7. The first way to read reviews is to click on a **red hyperlinked title** from within your email. The link takes you to the *Choice Reviews Online* database. You must **log in with the Username and Password you created** to see the review.

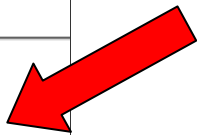

This is the first US edition of a provocative book originally published in Australia (1993, revised 2004). Accordingly, the conceptual basis for its unorthodox methodology and its treatment of the spiritual history of the West during the past half-millennium has already endured extended scholarly scrutiny. Although this is old wine in a new bottle, the author has expanded it to include the
