**2012 SUMMER SESSION II TUITION COURSE WAIVER
(ONLY NEW STUDENTS STARTING JULY 2012)**

DEADLINE: By 5:00pm Wednesday, April 25, 2012

GSSW will award a **limited** number of Summer Session II Tuition Course Waivers that will cover tuition for ONE summer session II course. The Summer Session II Tuition Course Waiver is awarded to **NEW** students starting the MSW program in Summer Session II (July 2012). **The applicant must apply for the Summer Session II Tuition Course Waiver and meet the following qualifications:**

1) Student must have earned a **minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0/4.0 scale or a 4.0/5.0 scale at their undergraduate institution.**

2) Student must be registered for a **minimum of 6 credit hours (2 courses)** in Summer Session II to be considered for the Tuition Course Waiver. The waiver will cover one of the two courses.

3) **Completed MSW Admissions Application.** In order to be considered for a Summer Session II Tuition Course Waiver, new students must submit a completed MSW admissions application (which includes all required admissions materials-- application, 3 letters of recommendation, personal statement, resume, application fee, and transcripts).

4) Completed and signed **Summer Session II Tuition Course Waiver Application Form.**

5) **Personal Statement.** In addition to submitting a personal statement for admission purposes, new students in a minimum of 2 typed pages must indicate how the award will assist in furthering your academic and professional goals in a globally focused and family centered MSW program.

Please note:

- Application to the Summer Session II Tuition Course Waiver will be disqualified if the same content is used from the admissions personal statement.
- Only one 2 page personal statement is required if the applicant is also applying for the 2012-2013 Dean's Scholarship or Graduate Assistantship. The question above must be addressed in 2 typed pages and the applicant must indicate at the beginning of the statement that he/she is applying for the Summer Session II Tuition Course Waiver and Dean's Scholarship and/or Graduate Assistantship.

DEADLINE: It is the responsibility of the applicant to make certain that all the above materials have been received **by 5:00pm on Wednesday, April 25, 2012.** Action on your Summer Session II Tuition Course Waiver cannot be taken until all your MSW admissions application and Summer Session II Tuition Course Waiver materials have been received.
