





To what extent did Dominican assist you in finding a job?





How well do you believe your degree program prepared you for your career?







The MBA/RD program is so unique and I feel that makes Dominican stand out among options.

Most of the teachers were very engaged and committed to helping, but the courses were riddled with grading errors, and one of the professors didn't respond to emails for months. When the courses are fully remote, it's important to have professors who are even more engaged than they would be in-person or else it feels like we're teaching ourselves from the books alone.

I was an undergrad at DU (then Rosary College), then taught part-time when earning my PhD (and later full-time as a tenured faculty member in Psychology), and have taught as a part-time faculty member since expanding my clinical practice (now a large group with multiple locations).
