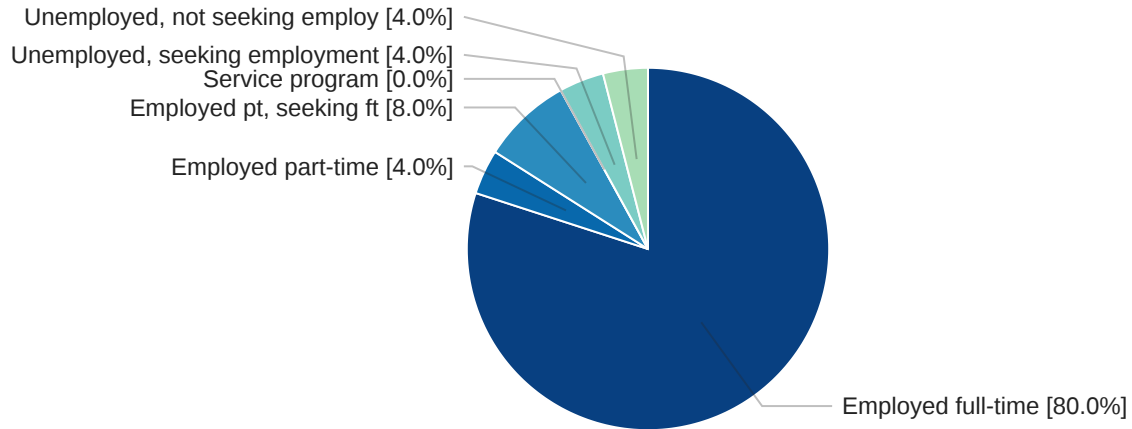

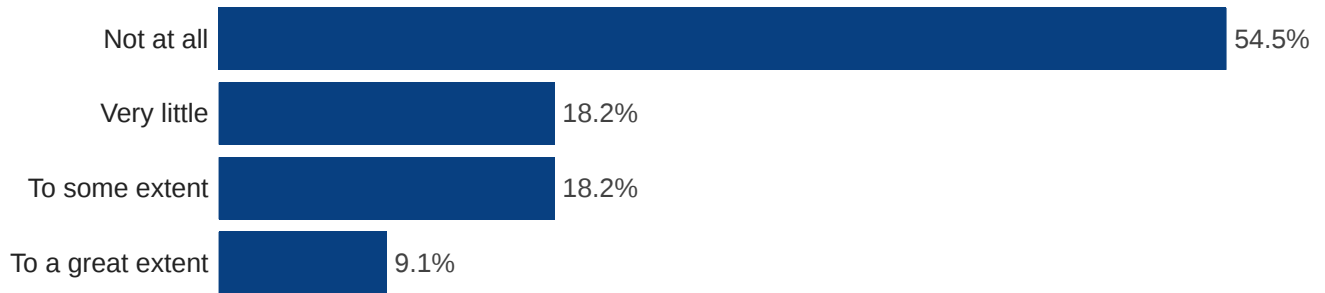

To what extent did Dominican assist you in finding a job?



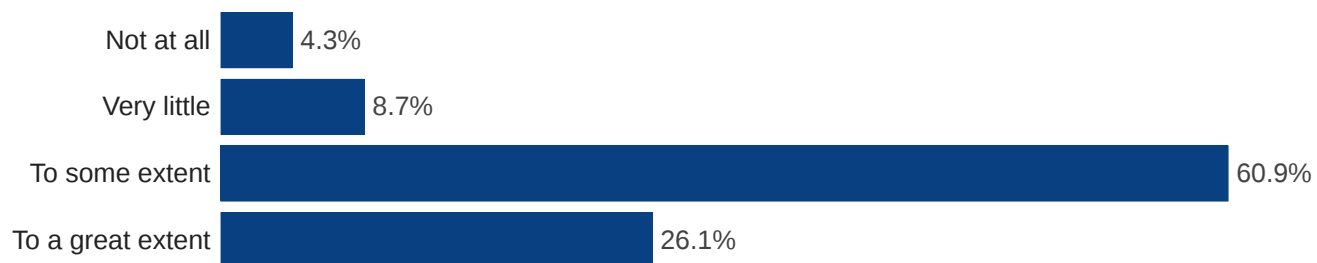

How well do you believe your degree program prepared you for your career?



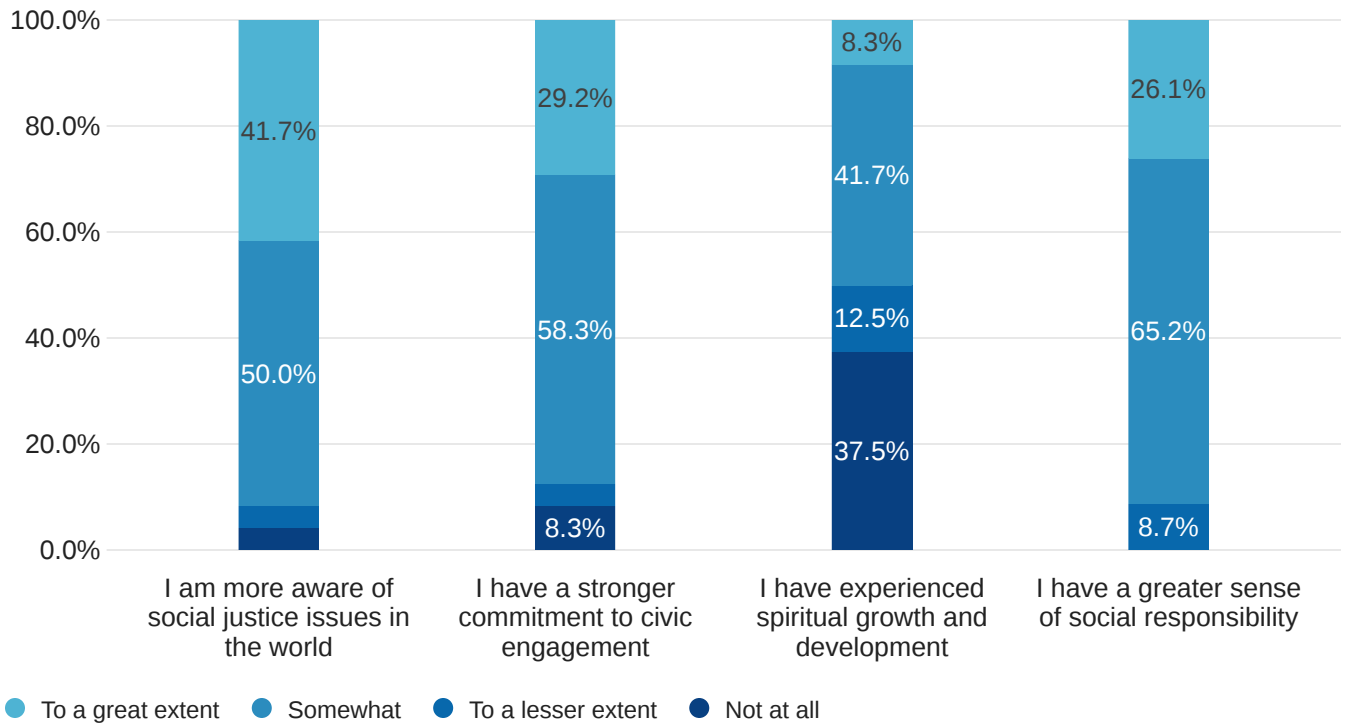

Everything that is being taught is about creating an environment that serves all patrons.

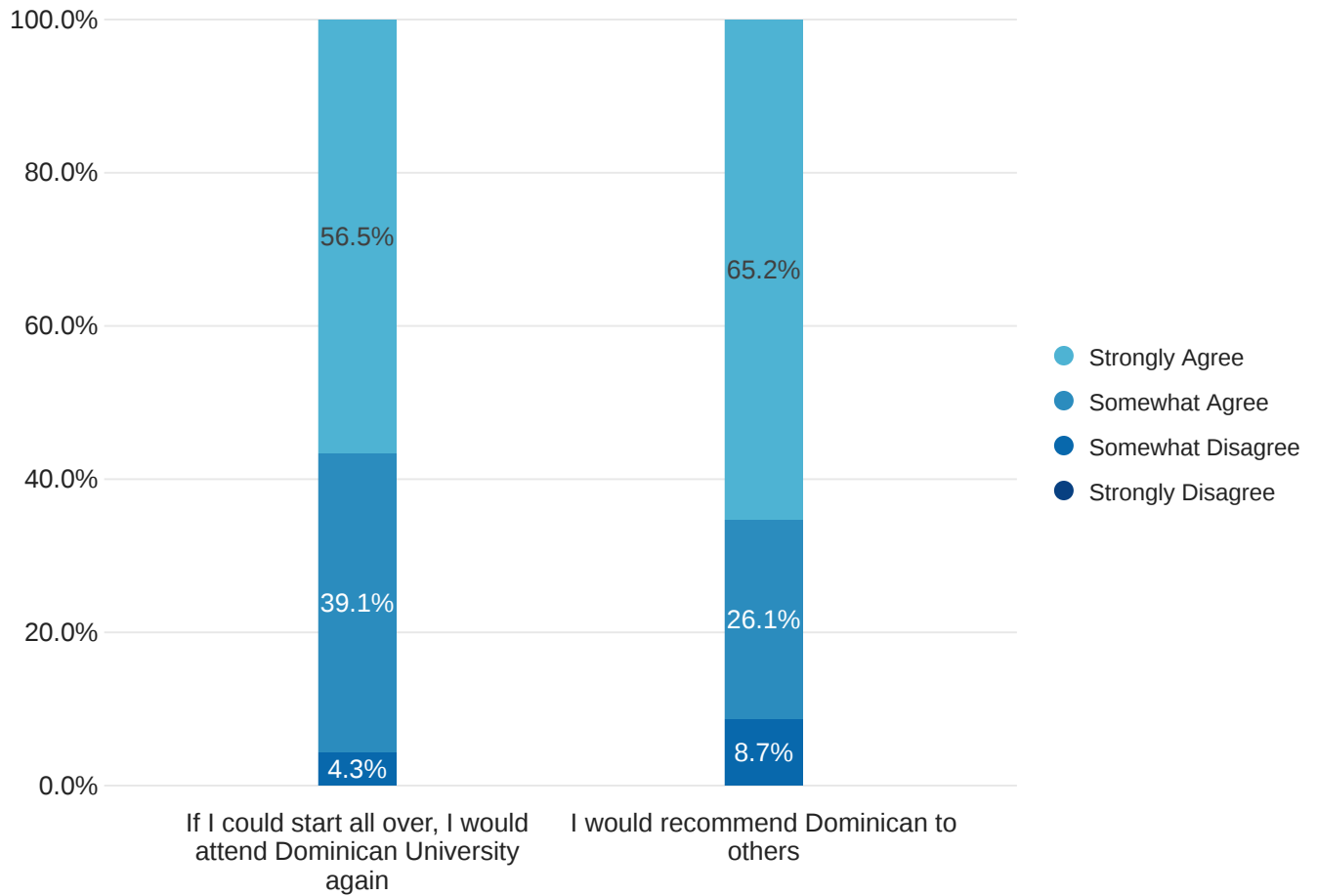
