## 2024 - 2025 Annual Cost of Attendance (full-time fall and spring semesters)

Below is cost of attendance information for undergraduate and graduate students. The information is based on full time enrollment in the fall and spring semesters. Examples of eligible expenses include but are not limited to, dependent care costs, rental or purchase of a computer, additional incurred program fees or expenses related to a student's disability.

Please note that the cost of attendance refers to both the direct costs incurred as well as allocations for indirect expenses. Indirect costs are not included on your student account statement.

Students who have costs associated with acquiring a first professional credential or license can have those fees included in the cost of attendance. The costs must be incurred during a period of enrollment, not after. These costs will be automatically included when the student incurs them. If a student does not see the cost included, please contact us at [finaid@dom.edu](mailto:finaid@dom.edu). Examples include fees charged to take a licensing exam and the costs of applying for and obtaining the license or certification. Note that the increased cost of attendance does not result in additional grant or scholarship eligibility but does allow for the potential for greater loan borrowing on federal student loans, a parent PLUS, graduate PLUS or private student loan. The teacher education preparation programs, both undergraduate and graduate, require the student to pass the content test prior to their final semester in which student teaching occurs. The cost is \$122. That cost will be added to teacher candidate students in the term prior to student teaching.

Students enrolled in the alternative licensure program are required to pass the content test as well as pay application fee and licensure costs in their first semester. \$252 will be added to their first semester cost of attendance.
