

### The Business Essentials Certificate

This program enables you to earn a valuable business certificate in just one semester. The powerful, highly flexible curriculum provides you with a fundamental understanding of the social, legal and economic environments of corporations and nonprofit organizations. You'll earn up to six credit hours. They can be applied toward the completion of advanced certificates, the MBA, or the Master of Science in Accounting. The certificate requires the Foundations in Management course and three-to-five additional one-credit foundation courses. Courses are offered on campus in the fall and spring and online in the fall and summer. Foundation classes are offered every semester.

### The Advanced Business Certificate

This certificate gives you a deep understanding of business fundamentals and in-depth knowledge in an academic concentration of your choice. You can complete the four-course curriculum in one year—and the 12 credit hours you earn can be applied toward the MBA or Master of Science in Accounting. In addition to a core MBA course, you'll complete three electives in one of seven high-demand areas of concentration: accounting, data analytics, finance, health care administration, leadership, international business, or marketing. Core classes are offered every semester; electives are offered on a rotating basis throughout the year. The concentrations in data analytics and health care administration are offered entirely online.
