2. Writing Samples. Please submit two writing samples that you have submitted for class assignments or for publication at Dominican.
3. Transcript. Contact the Registrar and arrange to pick up an official transcript to accompany your application. This service is free of charge. You can either pick up a copy of a transcript request form by stopping by Lewis 115 or by downloading it from the Registrar's myDU website.

Options for Submitting Your Application

1.
